National's evacuation operations relocate threatened civilians from locations in a host nation to secure areas. Normally, these operations involve U.K./Commonwealth citizens whose lives are in danger, either from the threat of hostilities or from a natural disaster. They may also include host-nation citizens and third-country nationals. Military forces, normally act as part of a joint task force, to evacuate diplomat and principal government related families as a contingency. We provide hostile evacuation operations to address any citizens who are not deemed suitable for the first wave of military evacuations. It usually involves swift insertions of a security force, temporary occupation of an agreed holding objective, and a planned withdrawal upon accomplishment of the objective. This operation can occur in three environments: permissive, uncertain, or hostile. The environment in which a noncombatant evacuation operation occurs quickly and can change from one to another with little warning. Valeré Partners prepare to operate in all three environments.

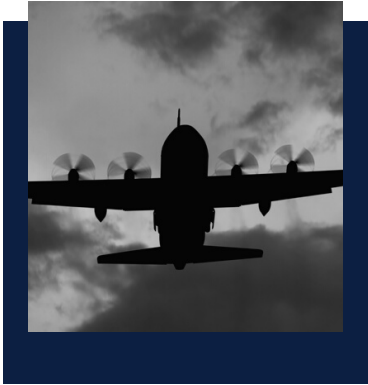
This task may include sustainment functions involving emergency medical treatment, transportation, administrative processing, and coordination with the principle lead on the ground and other agencies involved in the evacuation. Task operation is based on the operational environment in which the action is performed. However, since the environment can change rapidly, the permissive form of national's evacuation operations can become uncertain or hostile.

Outline Collective Taskings:

- Conduct Non-National Evacuation Order (Security Force in 2 separate phases)
- Provide Security / Police Support to Nationals Evacuation Operations
- Conduct Evacuation of Non Combatants to safe environment, local to Operational Area
- Home Nation repatriation

BEFORE ANYTHING ELSE PLANNING IS EVERYTHING!

Hostile Evacuation planning involves the careful selection and planning of the safest and most secure routes for an individual or group to be recovered. This is an essential component of a successful outcome, as it helps to mitigate potential risks and threats during the hostile phase. The following are some of the key considerations in Evacuation order planning:



1. Speed of Response

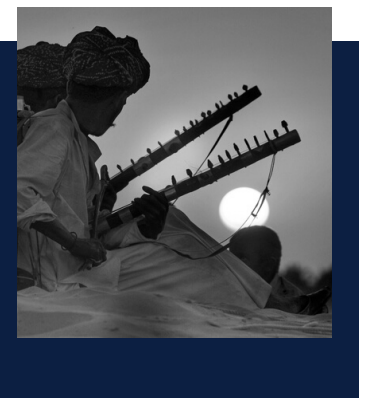
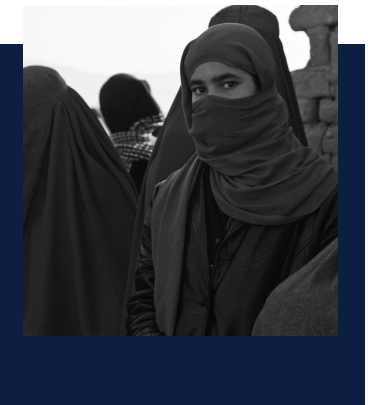
The national, regional and international political context and the unpredictable nature of a crisis can condense the period available to plan and execute a NEO. A review of any crisis management plans and any associated military contingency planning, all help towards producing your plan. operational plans at short notice.

2. Understanding

Paramount to any successful NEO is the level of understanding of the key destabilising factors within a country, along with a realistic assessment of future events. What cannot be mitigated against is the possibility that a previously 'no-risk' or 'low-risk' country degrades rapidly, leading to an urgent need for evacuation. The quick and efficient use of operational liaison and an advance reconnaissance and rapid deployment team will help develop an understanding of the crisis as it unfolds to support operational planning.

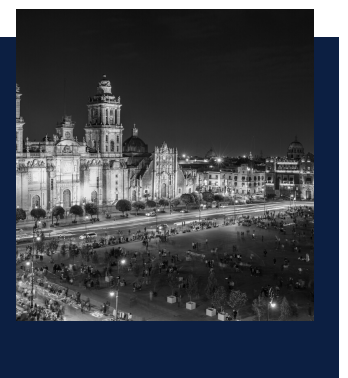
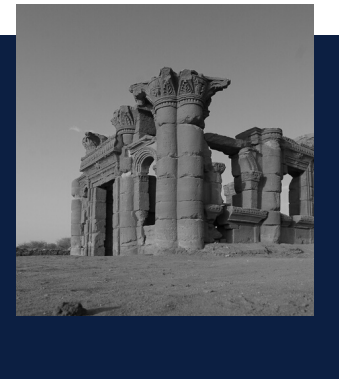
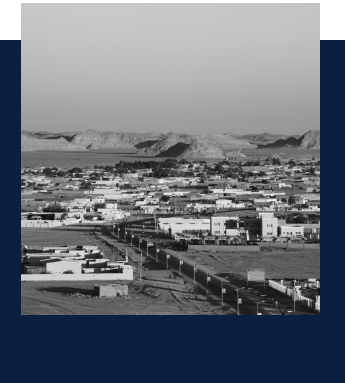
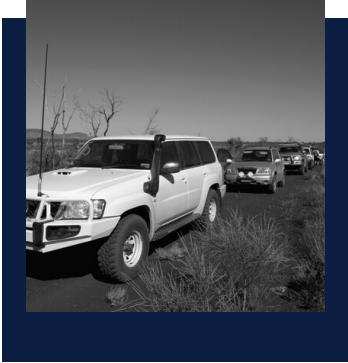
3. Recognised eligible persons picture.

Gaining clarity and information on the numbers and location of eligible persons requiring evacuation will be a priority for the planning community. A recognised eligible persons picture should be built and maintained for every country.

BEFORE ANYTHING ELSE PLANNING IS EVERYTHING!



As a crisis becomes increasingly imminent, we will endeavour to develop this picture; assisting this will be a recognised task. It will seldom be possible to provide absolute numbers and locations of eligible persons due to the constantly shifting numbers and locations of these eligible persons; · confusion about the eligibility of relatives and partners of nationals; and your limited ability to communicate in real time with eligible persons.

4. The recognised eligible persons picture and planning

Early liaison will help to establish a common recognised eligible persons picture for coherent planning. This picture will be an essential planning tool and will form the basis of the scaling of force elements, which are then held at readiness. Seldom will the picture be wholly accurate, and it will likely become inaccurate very quickly as eligible persons leave the crisis area without notification. Decision-making could be affected until every eligible person is accounted for.

5. An integrated approach.

Early engagement should help overcome potential misunderstandings over resource requirements and associated timelines. The decision to start integrating planning processes may be based on an independent assessment. A service level agreement forms the basis to agree liaison mechanisms that support an integrated approach, including functions such as strategic communication.
